

# WBBL RATINGS

**\*REVISED 10-19-11**

The Wisconsin Black Belt League is going through some exciting changes moving into the 2012 season pertaining to our ranking system. With this new system, competitors will immediately know how many points they gained based on their performance at each event. Competitors will find this ranking system much simpler and hopefully, more rewarding!

The first way to gain points in the Wisconsin Black Belt League is simply by attending WBBL Tournaments. For simply attending a WBBL Tournament, every competitor gains 10 points.

Once Preliminary Divisions are set, competitors are awarded with 10 points for each win in their Preliminary Division.

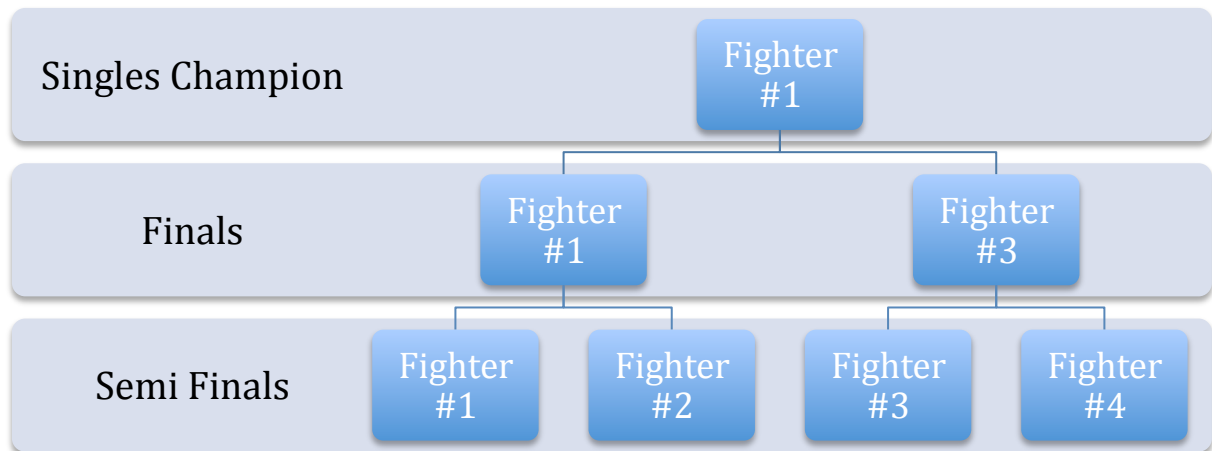
COMPETITORS	WINS	LOSSES
FIGHTER #1	3	0
FIGHTER #2	2	1
FIGHTER #3	2	1
FIGHTER #4	1	2

In the above example, Fighter #1 gained 30 points for 3 wins, Fighter #2 and #3 each gained 20 points for 2 wins, and Fighter #4 gained 10 points for 1 win. Fighter #1 won his division and will go on to Single Eliminations with 40 points. (10 points for attending the tournament and 30 points from his/her preliminary division)

It should be noted all fighters will now get three fights in their Preliminary Divisions. This will be done in order to ensure each fighter who wins their division will leave their Preliminary Division with a total of 30 possible points. (3 wins) The WBBL wants to ensure no competitors get an unfair advantage by getting more or less than three fights in the Preliminary Divisions.

At this point the winners of the preliminary division will go on to compete in Single Elimination. To keep things simple, fighters again will be awarded 10 points for each win through Single Elimination.

As you can see in the below example, Fighter #1 won two fights in Single Elimination awarding him 20 more points. Fighter #3 won one fight awarding him an additional 10 points in addition to his/her previous points. Fighter #1 finishes the competition with 60 points. (10 points for attending, 30 points in Prelims, 20 points in Single Elimination)



It should also be noted, the rankings will be separated between Men and Women. Furthermore, Tag Team has no impact in individual ratings. Fighters will also not be awarded points in the Grand Champion Round.

In addition to attending WBBL Tournaments, fighters can also be awarded points for attending and placing in WBBL Recommended Tournaments throughout the area. Competitors will be awarded a total of 10 points for attending the tournaments, 15 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> place, 20 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place, and 30 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place.
